1. - The seminar-workshop aims to:
 - 1.1 upgrade the teaching methodology in cosmetology;

 - 1.3 develop the skills in modern haircutting techniques; and
 - 1.4 develop skills in the operation of modern equipment, machine on hair, facial and skin care freatment.
- Participants to the seminar-workshop are secondary school teachers and department heads of THE.
- Attendance of participants from public schools is on Official time only.
- Registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000) per participant includes snacks and funch for 5 days and one mannequin with long hair and clamp to be used as model in the workshop. However, participants have the option not to purchase the mannequin. Thus, registration fee will only cost P1,750.00. Hair coloring cream, bleaching powder, exidizing lotion, styling aid shall be provided (free) to all participants by Splash Manufacturing Corporation.
