## HEALTH ADVISORY ON DENGUE FEVER UPSURGE

To: Schools Superintendents

**District Supervisors** 

Principals/Heads of Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Health has warned about the increased number of dengue cases since January 1, 2001 compared to the same period last year. Majority of the cases are school-aged children from highly urbanized areas.
- 2. Schools pose as high risk areas for the rapid transmission of dengue because it is a confined area and the potential victims are young and physically vulnerable children.
- 3. Therefore, school principals and supervisors should ensure the cleanliness of their schools. The usual breeding sites of the *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, like flower vases, empty cans, bottles and old tires should be disposed of or periodically emptied.
- 4. Toilets must be kept clean at all times.
- 5. Teachers must be vigilant in observing signs of sickness among schoolchildren and act on this accordingly.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with the Order is enjoined.
