> > ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE PAMBANSANG SAMAHAN PARA SA PAGPAPAHALAGA (PSEP), INC.

- The Pambansang Samahan Para sa Pagpapahalaga (PSEP), Inc. will hold its 11th Annual Convention at Villa Punta, Iloilo City on April 20-22, 2001 with the theme "Ugnayan, Damayan, Pananagutan: Tungo sa Pambansang Paghilom".
- 2. The convention aims to:
 - provide the participants with knowledge and insights brought about by a) EDSA 2 and the challenges it offers to the Values Educators;
 - share realizations and reflections inspired by EDSA 2 among the b) youths; and
 - exchange and share expertise in the strategies, activities, instructional C) materials, contents, etc. for more effective teaching of Education across the levels.
- Participants to the convention are PSEP and K-PSEP officers and members, teachers, coordinators, department heads of Values Education and GMRC, principals and supervisors in public and private elementary and secondary schools. Participants from public schools are allowed to attend on official time only. Those from private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools/institutions.
- A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500.00) will be charged for regular PSEP member and Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2, 500.00) for K-PSEP member to cover expenses of convention materials, accommodations, snacks and lunch for the duration of the convention. Live-out participants will pay regular fees and meals amounting to Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) for each PSEP member and Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) for K-PSEP member. An additional membership fee of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P150.00) will also be charged to members for renewal and nonmembers who intend to become members.
- Participants are requested to prepare a presentation for the cultural night. Prizes await the winners. They may fill up a nomination form for the election of PSEP Board and members on April 20 and submit their resume and picture to the Election Committee on the said date. The nominee should be a regular and active member of PSEP and should be present during the convention.
