**2001 NATIONAL YOUTH SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY,
AND ENVIRONMENT SUMMER CAMP**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Private Secondary Schools Principals

1. The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC), Inc., in partnership with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports – Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DECS-CSCA), announces the holding of the 2001 National Youth Science and Technology, and Environment Summer Camp (CAMP 2001) from April 3-9, 2001 at the Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Capitol Hills Scout Camp, Cebu City for PSYSC-affiliated high school students nationwide.
2. With the theme "Cutting-Edge Technologies: A Peek Into the Future", Camp 2001 aims to provide learning experiences and exposure to the participants and enable them to comprehend and delve further into the cutting-edge developments in science and technology and their significance to the future of our country. It will be composed of a series of lectures, workshops, situationers, synthesis, group dynamics, field trips, socials and plant visits.
3. Each science club may send a maximum of six (6) students and one (1) teacher-adviser only. Applicants in excess of the maximum will not be accepted.
4. Travel expenses, registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 3,500.00) and other incidental expenses to this activity may be sourced from the Local School Board and/or various organizations to ensure maximum participation. The registration fee will cover lodging and meals from dinner of April 3 to the afternoon snacks of April 9, handouts, field trips, and other miscellaneous expenses. A solicitation letter is enclosed to which may be reproduced.
5. Interested applicants must submit on or before March 23, 2001 the following requirements to be considered reserved:
 - a. Duly accomplished application forms;
 - b. School Principal's endorsement letter for the whole delegation;
 - c. Parental consent;
 - d. Medical certificate (including the adviser);

- e. A non-refundable reservation deposit of Seven Hundred Pesos (Php 700.00) per participant (deductible from the registration fee) payable only to the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC), Inc. and deposited at any Land Bank of the Philippines under Account No. 0702-1020-65 or through Postal Money Order and postmarked to ***Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC), Inc., 317 C David's Place, Katipunan Avenue, 1108 Loyola Heights, Quezon City.*** The reservation fee is transferable only to other participants of the same school but may not be used to add to the registration fee of other participants.
 - f. Copy of the original and duly validated deposit slip, a photocopy of which must be kept for verification purposes.
6. Each participant must bring the balance of the registration fee to be paid upon registration, enough clothes and pocket money for seven (7) days, including costumes for the cultural presentation and 2 semi-formal clothes for the opening and closing ceremonies, toiletries, personal medication and other personal effects.
 7. Only 700 slots are available and processing will be on a first-come-first-served and regional quota bases depending on the number of science clubs in a particular region. *In view of this and since the reservation fee is non-refundable, interested applicants must first call the PSYSC National Office at (02) 920-8174/920-9561 or email at psysc@j-next.net to verify availability of slots and wait for a reply before remittance of the reservation fee.* Confirmation slips will be mailed directly to accepted participants. If no confirmation arrives by March 28, 2001, participants must call or email the PSYSC.
 8. The registration period is from 7:00 AM – 3:00 PM of April 3, 2001 only. Participants who cannot come during the registration period must inform the PSYSC at least 5 days in advance.
 9. Application Forms, which are also be available at the PSYSC National Office, DECS Regional and Division Offices and DOST Regional and Provincial Offices, shall be sent directly to all PSYSC-affiliated science clubs.
