ORIENTATION AND SKILLS ENHANCEMENT TRAINING IN TEAM SPORTS UNDER THE DECS SPECIAL SPORTS PROGRAM

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. The Special Sports Program of this Department shall be in its second phase of implementation in SY 2001-2002, and shall focus on gymnastics, taekwondo and the following team sports: basketball, volleyball, softball/baseball and soccer.
- 2. In preparation for the second phase of program implementation, there shall be an orientation for the School Principals/PEHM Department Heads of pilot schools and Regional Sports Coordinators on April 20, 2001 at the BSE Conference Room, 3rd Floor Bonifacio Building, DECS Central Office. This shall be followed by a skills enhancement training of teacher-trainers/coaches on May 6-11, 2001 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The teacher-trainer participants must be those with specialized knowledge and skills in the aforecited sports events. Each pilot school is entitled to send one (1) teacher-trainer for each of the six sports events. It is preferred, however, that for gymnastics and taekwondo, the teacher-trainers be those who attended the summer training on May 8-12, 2000.
- 3. Travelling expenses of participants in these activities shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Board and lodging and other training expenses shall be borne by the Bureau of Secondary Education.

4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
