**THIRD ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION
OF PROFESSIONAL TEACHERS**

To: Regional Directors
School Division/City Superintendents
District Supervisors
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The National Organization of Professional Teachers, Inc. (NOPTI), is duly recognized by the Board for Professional Teachers and the Professional Regulation Commission as the "one and only integrated and accredited association of professional teachers," as provided in Sec. 22, R.A. No. 7836. The Organization works in coordination with this Department in the continuing professionalization of all public and private school teachers in the elementary and secondary levels.
2. Pursuant to this mandate, NOPTI, in coordination with DECS, will be holding its 3rd Annual Convention at the Development Academy of the Philippines, Tagaytay City on October 5-6, 2001 with theme "The Filipino Teacher in Search for Excellence."
3. The convention aims to:
 - a. strengthen the management and leadership competencies of teachers in their continuing search to do a better job of facilitating the learning process and of enabling the Filipino youth to survive in a highly competitive world.
 - b. take a close look at the major issues and concerns facing the teachers to transform Filipino learners into productive members of society.
 - c. forge a national plan of action that will challenge teachers and speed up their transformation to a culture of excellence as professionals.
4. Participants to this convention are members and officers of NOPTI in the district, division and regional levels both in private and public schools.

5. The registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) to be charged each participant to cover expenses for food, accommodation, honoraria of speakers, conference materials and other expenses incurred in the attendance to the congress are chargeable from NOPTI funds in the district, division and regional levels.
6. Pre-registration with payment by district, division and region is requested. Such payment will be remitted to Mrs. Erlinda S. Dayos, Chairman, Committee on Finance. If funds are not yet available, the confirmed list of participants should likewise be submitted on or before October 1, 2001. Attendance will be on official time only.
7. Check-in is after lunch of Friday, October 5, at 1:00 p.m. Opening ceremonies will be at 2:30 p.m. Closing ceremonies will be on October 6, Saturday, at 5:00 p.m.
