PERSONAL COMPUTERS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROJECT

Schools Division/City Superintendents

- In line with the thrust of the Department to intensify its efforts of facilitating learning and enhancing learner performance through the provision of the latest instructional tools, this Department, in partnership with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), other government agencies and the private sector is implementing the Personal Computers (PCs) for Public Schools Project.
- Funding requirements for the implementation of the Project are provided for by a 2. six hundred million pesos grant from the Government of Japan under the Non-Project Grant Assistance Program. One thousand public secondary schools across the sixteen regions will become recipients of a package consisting of computers and peripherals, teacher training, software programs, instructional guides and support materials. The recipient-schools have been selected on the basis of a selection criteria developed in consultation with the Regional Offices.
- 3. To effect the inspection, acceptance and proper turn-over of the computer packages under the Project, a joint Technical Inspection and Acceptance Team (TIAT) consisting of DECS and DTI personnel shall be created.

To ensure the effective and efficient implementation of the Project, the Schools Division Superintendents are requested to immediately conduct an inspection of the recipient-schools to determine their compliance to the requirements of the Project and to submit on or before September 28, 2001 a certification of compliance to the Office of Undersecretary Ernesto S. Pangan (Attn: Ms. Marivic Abcede), DECS, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.
