1. The Po Leung Kuk of Hongkong, a non-profit making organization and one of the largest school sponsors in Hongkong, announces the 2001 International Year of Volunteers, Love Without Border, Art and Design Competition.

**【2001 International Year of Volunteers, Love Without Border,
Art and Design Competition】**

Aims: The aim of the competition is to raise students' awareness of the importance of volunteer service, to encourage them to offer their services to the community. It is hoped that this competition will promote the spirit of volunteerism in the youth of Hong Kong and provide them with an opportunity to contribute to society.

Organizer: The Po Leung Kuk of Hong Kong

Co-organizers: The Education Department of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region
The Hong Kong Institute of Education
The Hong Kong Society for Education in Art

Theme of Artwork: The artwork should clearly express the students' personal thoughts and feelings about 'volunteer service'.

Age Groups:

Media: Artwork can be made with various media and styles which include drawing, painting, printmaking, collage, sculpture, three dimensional construction, computer graphic or with any other skills and materials. Please note that entries may not be mounted, folded or rolled-up.

Sizes: Two-dimensional artwork: Up to 84 cm x 120 cm maximum
Three-dimensional artwork: Up to 84 cm x 100 cm x 120 cm maximum
Please note that entries may not be mounted, folded or rolled-up.

Criteria of Adjudication: Include creativity, skill and expression of the theme of the artwork and participant's way of expression.

Number of Entries: Each school should not submit more than 5 entries for each age group. Each participant should not submit more than one entry. Artwork should not have been submitted to any other competitions or exhibitions.

Submission of Entries: Participants should fill in the separate entry form, and stick the label of entry at the bottom right corner on the back of their artworks. Please submit the entries together with the entry form to Po Leung Kuk Tsing Yi Secondary School (Skills Opportunity), Ching Chin Street, Area 7, Tsing Yi, N.T. Hong Kong between 1st November, 2001 and 15th November, 2001 inclusive, by mail or by hand. Also please state '2001 International Year of Volunteers, Love Without Border, Art and Design Competition' on the envelope. All entries submitted will not be returned and the copyright of all artworks will belong to the organizer.

Awards: Outstanding remarkable entries of each age group will receive awards from the organizer. Each participating school will receive 5 certificates honoring her participants' achievement. All schools are given the discretion to choose and award the winners.

Adjudication Panel: A panel of experts will be invited to select the artworks and their decision is final.

Exhibition: All winning and outstanding entries will be displayed in the Hong Kong and International Joint Art Exhibition on '2001 International Year of Volunteers, Love Without Border, Art and Design Competition' on March, 2002, at Hong Kong. All the details will be announced later.

Prize Presentation Ceremony: The prizes will be awarded on March, 2002. This will also be the first day of the Hong Kong and International Joint Art Exhibition on '2001 International Year of Volunteers, Love Without Border, Art and Design Competition'. All the details will be announced later.

Publication: An art book featuring all the winning entries will be published. All entries submitted will become the property of the organizer. Each participating school and winning student will receive one art book.
