

Within the frameworks of the pedagogical and educational school syllabuses and activities towards the universal civilization, love and Peace which can only be sensed by the pure souls of the children, we are getting prepared to present the 10th International Exhibition of Children's Paintings under the subject: THE OLYMPIC GAMES TOWARDS CIVILIZATION, LOVE AND PEACE FOR THE PEOPLES OF THE ENTIRE WORLD which will be held in the year 2004 in the city of Athens in Greece.

It would be a great honor and pleasure for us if your country took part through your Embassy to the above mentioned 10th International Exhibition of Children's Paintings, communicating our document to the relevant organizations in your country in order for your school students to participate and draw paintings under the stated subject.

Within the frameworks of the settled regular Olympic Games, as it is widely known, there are also the Para Olympic Games for people with Special Needs (physical disabilities) which take place after the end of the settled Olympic Games, an effort we apprise and side up with.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- School students will draw and express themselves with facts and images of the Olympic games previously seen in the past symbolizing the present and the future of the athletic spirit of the Olympic games.
- Number of Paintings: 10 paintings depicting athletes of the regular Olympic games and 2 paintings inspired from the Para Olympic games of persons with Special Needs (disabled).

COMPONENTS: The children's works of painting should be drawn on plain painting paper by choice of the painting material preferably of the student's: felt-tipped pens, watercolors, finger paints, temperas.

PAINTINGS' DIMENSIONS: Approximately 45cm width - 35cm height.

- On the painting in the front-page on the down right corner, there should be a small label with the first and last name of the child, their age, their sex and their country written in English block capitals. Furthermore, on the back-page of the painting there should be again the same data together with the address of the school and the name of the country in English.
- CHILDREN'S GROUP OF AGE: The children painting the subject should be 7 - 14 years old and they should be students of regular schools as well as of schools for children with Special Needs (students with physical disabilities). It should be explained on the backside of the painting whether athletes of the Olympic or of the Para Olympic games are being portrayed.

NOTE: The participation in the 10th International Exhibition of Children's Paintings under the subject: THE OLYMPIC GAMES 2004 TOWARDS THE CIVILIZATION, LOVE AND PEACE FOR THE PEOPLES OF THE ENTIRE WORLD is free with no economic charge at all of the participating countries.

- AWARDS: From each country three (3) works of children's paintings will be awarded a parchment and a medal of equal complimentary value. The distinguished students will be nominated: Olympic winner painters for THE OLYMPIC GAMES 2004 TOWARDS THE CIVILIZATION, LOVE AND PEACE FOR THE PEOPLES OF THE ENTIRE WORLD.

NOTE: The children's paintings will not be returned. They will be published in a special collection album designated to the Olympic Games

NOTE: The mentioned Painting Exhibition THE OLYMPIC GAMES 2004 will be held in view of the athletic event.


NOTE: Deadline for the entry of the works of painting – till the end of March 2002.
