NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF SCHOOLS SUPERINTENDENTS

1. Schools superintendents occupy a key and strategic position in the DECS organization. The attainment of the two goals of the Department, namely: to raise the academic standards of basic education and enhance administrative efficiency in the delivery of educational services, therefore, hinges greatly in the performance by the schools superintendents of their primary function.
2. It is important and timely for schools superintendent to meet to assess and redefine systems and strategies in the implementation of programs and thrusts in education at the school level in the most efficient and effective manner given the resources available. Schools superintendents also need to focus on the national vision of prosperity, freedom and justice enunciated by President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo.
3. The theme of the national conference is, "Schools Superintendency in the 21st Century".
4. The national conference will be held on November 14-16, 2001 at the Cebu Plaza, Cebu City.
5. Participants to the conference are schools division superintendents, assistant schools division superintendents, regional/bureau directors, assistant regional/bureau directors, and members of the working committees.
6. A conference fee of P4,500.00 shall be charged to cover board and lodging of participants, resource speakers and support staff including conference materials and other related conference expenses. Attendance to this conference shall be on official business. *n*
