**NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE OF CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS
 OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION**

1. The Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education meet bi-annually to share innovations, experiences and ideas; to review progress of elementary education projects; and to formulate policies and plans that address identified issues and concerns. This year's second conference will be held on 19-23 November 2001 at the Governors' Garden Hotel, J. Manzano, Corner Gaddang Street, Solano, Nueva Vizcaya with Region II as the host.

3. Focused on teacher development and welfare, the conference will be guided by the theme "*Best Performing Teachers, Best Performing Learners*" and will pursue the following objectives:


- a. to identify teacher-related factors affecting the least performing schools;
- b. to identify innovative strategies to further enhance teacher competencies; and
- c. to forge national and regional plans for teacher development and welfare

3. Participants to this work-conference are the chiefs and assistant chiefs of the Elementary Education Division (EED) of the sixteen (16) regions, and the director, assistant director, division chiefs, and assistant chiefs of the Bureau of Elementary Education. All participants are requested to report on the regional/bureau initiatives concerning teacher development and welfare for SY 1999-2000 to the present. A suggested format is attached for reference, including the list of participants and program of activities.

4. All participants are expected to be at the venue on Monday, 19 November 2001 in time for the opening program at 1:30 in the afternoon. Check-in is in the morning of the same day and hotel meals will start at breakfast. Check-out will be after breakfast on Friday, 23 November 2001.

7. Travel expenses and a registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) per participant to cover board and lodging and other related expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
