

**FOURTH NATIONAL CONGRESS OF
PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS**

To: **Regional Directors**
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Philippine Association of Public Secondary School Administrators (PAPSSA), in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) will hold its Fourth National Congress on December 3-6, 2001 at the Cebu Grand Hotel, Cebu City. The theme of the congress is **"A Closer Look at the People that Count (An Executive Briefing on Peer Accreditation)**.
2. The Congress intends to lay the groundwork for the setting up of a Peer Accreditation System for public high schools, a joint undertaking of the Department of Education, Ford Foundation, Philippine Association of Public Secondary School Administrators, and the University of Asia and the Pacific.
3. Participants to this congress are Principals/Head Teachers/Master Teachers/TICs of public secondary schools, Regional Chiefs, Assistant Chiefs and Supervisors of Secondary Education Divisions and Schools Division Superintendents and Assistant Schools Division Superintendents in charge of secondary education. Attendance to this conference shall be on **official business**.
4. Members of the different committees shall be considered participants and shall pay the conference fee and are authorized to travel two days before the congress. First congress meal will be dinner on December 3, and the last, dinner on December 6.
