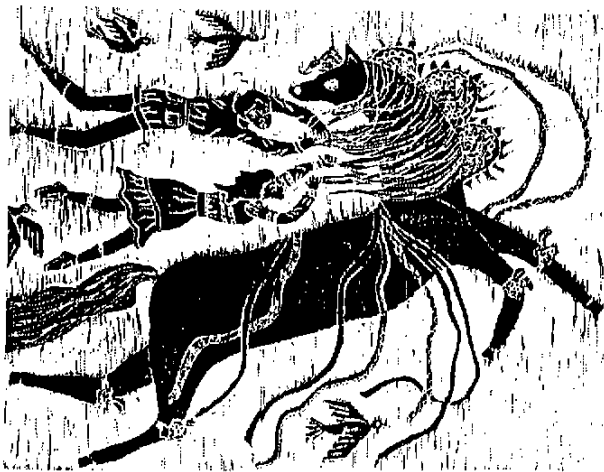

7th International Reward Competition on the theme The HORSE

The World of Art magazine announces 7th International Reward Competition for children's art works on the theme The Horse. The collection on this theme has reached 25,000 of art works so far, from 42 countries all over the world, which represents the biggest collection of the kind in the world. Certain art works from this collection have been exhibited in Moscow (Russia), Paris (France), Belgrade, Podgorica, Subotica, Kikinda (FR Yugoslavia), Kecskemet (Hungary), Katowice, Opole, Myskow, Czestochowa (Poland), Kishinjev (Moldova), Osijek (Croatia), Villa Constitucion (Argentina), Slovenska Bistrica, Jesenice, Slovenske Konjice and Celje (Slovenia). Young artists and their mentors are kindly invited to join us again this year with their art works, the World of Art, however, will take care of their promotion and exhibitions.

THE COMPETITION

- All children of the world aged 5 to 20 can enter the competition.
 - The number of entries per child or per school is not limited.
 - Art techniques: tempera, watercolour, dry pastel, graphics.
 - The size of the paper should not exceed A3 (30 X 42 cm).
 - The art works should be sent by 15th January, 2002.
- By 1st February 2002, the jury of two academic painters and three art teachers will have examined the entries and awarded the following prizes:

PRIZES FOR INDIVIDUALS

I. THREE EQUAL PRIZES WITH GOLDEN HORSE

The World of Art will invite three first prize winners and their mentors to the opening ceremony in Celje for three days in May 2002. Lodging expenses will be paid by The World of Art, the organizers, however, will not cover the travel expenses.

II. 50 EQUAL UNIQUE PRIZES FOR THE AGE GROUP FROM 5 TO 10 YEARS

III. 50 EQUAL UNIQUE PRIZES FOR THE AGE GROUP FROM 11 TO 15 YEARS

IV. 50 EQUAL UNIQUE PRIZES FOR THE AGE GROUP FROM 16 TO 20 YEARS

VI. 10 UNIQUE PRIZES OF THE SLOVENE BOARD OF UNICEF

A special jury of UNICEF will award ten entries by their choice. The awarded art works will be exhibited and the winners will be awarded at the opening ceremony.

PRIZES FOR COLLECTIONS

I. THREE EQUAL UNIQUE PRIZES WITH GOLDEN HORSE

The collection should contain at least 10 art works.

II. 30 EQUAL UNIQUE PRIZES

The collection should contain at least 10 art works.

III. A SPECIAL AWARD FOR ALL INSTITUTIONS WHICH WILL SEND MORE THAN 50 CHILDREN'S ART WORKS.

Art works awarded with the prizes for collections will be exhibited on the occasion of the opening ceremony (three best entries will represent the whole collection).

The reverse side of the entries should contain the following data:

- name, surname and age of the child.
- name and surname of the teacher or mentor,
- the school,
- the country.

All entries for the competition should be divided into separate maps according to the age groups:

- A) children up to 10 years,
- B) children from 11 to 15 years,
- C) young people from 16 to 20 years.

Entries which do not comply with the terms of the competition will not be evaluated by the jury.

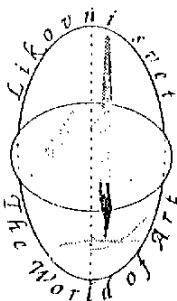
