1. This year, 2002, marks the first time that the country will observe two separate events that are linked by the people's struggle for good governance, the **EDSA PEOPLE POWER I** on February 21-25, 1986 and the **EDSA PEOPLE POWER II** on January 16 to 20, 2001. The theme of this year's celebration is **ISABUHAY ANG EDSA: "MATAPAT NA PAMAMAHALA : TUGON SA KAHIRAPAN"**.

2. The objectives of the celebration include the following :

- a. Catalyze and promote faith and hope in the Filipino capacity to transform and grow into an empowered sustainable society.
- b. Commemorate and draw strength from the two historic events where people in their numbers asserted their right to good governance.
- c. Encourage and provide time/space for debate and discourse between and among the citizens regarding the development path to take so that democracy and justice will thrive in society.
- d. Promote concerted effort of various stakeholders in poverty alleviation/ radicalion.

3. In support of this program, DepEd Officials, regional/division offices and schools are hereby enjoined to actively participate in the nationwide celebrations of the **EDSA PEOPLE POWER I** and **II** on January 16 to February 25, 2002.

4. Likewise, the DepEd Central Office will hold a one (1) day OPEN HOUSE wherein the children, youth, teachers, school officials and NGO's can present their problems, expectations and aspirations to our department officials. (please see attached DepEd program for January 21, 2002)

## I. PROPOSED TAG-LINES TO THE COMPLAN

### ***Tamang panimula: Matapat na pamamahala.***

1. Ang di tumaas na halaga ng transportasyon naglingkod sa pag-estable ng pagkain.
2. 200,000 pamilya ay ngayon ay may sariling bahay at lupa.
3. 30 ospital sa kalakhang Maynila nagbebenta ng 8 palaging ginagamit na gamot sa kalahati ng halaga.
4. 1,000 Rolling stores nagbebenta ng P14 kilo ng bigas.
5. Mga magnyonyog na magsasaka tinulungang makatawid sa gutom sa pamamagitan ng targeted rice subsidy; ang coconut levy fund issue kumilos tungo sa paggamit ng maliliit na magsasaka ng nyog para sa pagpapaunlad ng buhay nila.
6. 100,000 hektarya ang napasakamay ng magsasaka dahil sa repormang agraryo.
7. May ilaw na sa karamihan ng barangay upang mabigyan sigla sa kanayunan (83% of the brgys. in the Philippines have been energized).
8. Mga kabataan pinakingan sa pamamagitan ng Pambansang Ugong na Kabataan (PUNK) 2001.
9. 10,000 kabataan nagbenepisyo sa emergency employment sa kalakhang maynila.
10. mga unang hakbang sa pagpapanday ng mga maunlad na pamayanan sa Central Mindanao: 145 Evacuation centers March 2001, 5 Evacuation centers December 2001.
11. Ceasefire sa pagitan ng MILF at GRP at patuloy na paguusap ng kapayapaan o Peace Talk sa pagitan ng NDF at GRP.
12. Patuloy na pagpapatupad ng Peace Agreement sa pagitan ng MNLF at GRP; bagong halal na ARMM officials at patuloy na pagsasagawa ng proyektong pangkaunlaran.
13. Dalawang (2) bilyong piso naipagawa ng irigasyon o patubig nagbigay ng kabuhayan sa kanayunan.
14. 2,000 batang lansangan nalikas at nabigyan ng pagkakataong magkabagong buhay; 1,302,874 bilang ng Day Care Center nagbibigay ng kalinga sa ating mga bata.

## **II. PROPOSED FORMS OF COMMUNICATION**

1. People who have benefited from these programs - such as women who got micro-credit, families who are already paying for their own house and lot - with cabinet members responsible for the programs or on their own being interviewed on radio and TV.
