AWARDING CEREMONY FOR THE NATIONAL SEARCH FOR THE MOST EFFECTIVE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

To: Regional Directors

School Division/City Superintendents

- 1. The awarding ceremony of the Search for the Most Effective Public Elementary Schools will be held at the Bulwagan ng Karunungan, Department of Education, Pasig City on March 1, 2002 at 1:30 p.m.
- 2. The highest ranking central and non-central schools will be adjudged as the national winners and each will receive a cash prize of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P 100,000.00) and a trophy. The second and third ranking central and non-central schools will also receive a trophy each while the fourth and fifth in rank will receive plaque of recognition. Special awards will be given to schools which got the highest achievement tests in English, Science and/or Math and those that have the best special programs in English, Science and /or Math.
- 3. The regional director, school superintendent, district supervisor, principal and a representative from the PTCA organization of the winning schools are invited to attend the awarding ceremony. The following schools are adjudged winners in the different categories:
