POLIO FREE MAINTENANCE IMMUNIZATION CAMPAIGN (PFMIC)

To : Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Department of Health has launched the Polio Free Maintenance Immunization Campaign (PFMIC) for 2002 through the conduct of polio-catch-up immunization projects termed as "Door-to-Door Patak and Polio-Catch-Up Patak" in order to raise the Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) coverage to 100%. This is to prevent the circulation of the wild poliovirus in the country.

2. To ensure the success of the PFMIC, the school health and nutrition personnel and school administrators shall take the lead in the information campaign on this activity through bulletin board display, write-ups or streamers, PTCA meetings and disseminating the information during the flag ceremony.
