**2002 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON HEARING IMPAIRMENT,
EDUCATIONAL AUDIOLOGY AND MENTAL RETARDATION**

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education in coordination with Christoffel Blindenmission International (CBMI) is sponsoring training programs in the following areas for Summer 2002 at the designated institution or venues:

A. Hearing Impairment

- Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired
 - Luzon - (First Batch) Philippine Normal University, Taft Ave., Manila - April 15 - May 10, 2002
 - Visayas - (New and Old Batch) Cebu Normal University, Osmena Blvd., Cebu City - April 15 - May 16, 2002
 - Mindanao - (New and Old Batches) Holy Cross College, Sta. Ana Ave., Davao City - May 2-25, 2002

B. Educational Audiology

- Short-Term Training of Teachers for the Deaf on Educational Audiology, University - Sto. Tomas, Espana, Manila, May 13-15, 2002.

C. Mental Retardation

- ❖ Live-in Training Workshop for Teachers of Children with Mental Retardation
 - Luzon - Brentwood Apartelle, Baguio City - April 15-23, 2002
 - Visayas - ECOTECH Center, Cebu City - May 22-30, 2002
 - Mindanao - RELC, Davao City - May 6-14, 2002

2. These programs aim to upgrade competencies of teachers in providing educational services to children with hearing impairment and those with mental retardation. The training programs will include restructuring of the Basic Learning Competencies (BLCs) in consonance with the implementation of the restructured curriculum.

3. Priority participants/nominees shall come from the identified regions/divisions/schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the hearing impaired and the mentally retarded. (See Enclosures Nos. 1-3). Applicants shall be screened by the Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 4. Deadline for the submission of nominees to the region is on March 15, 2002. The list of nominees together with the documents listed in Inclosure No. 4 shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education not later than March 27, 2002.


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4. Teachers trained in the 2001 Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired at Cebu Normal University, Cebu City and Holy Cross College, Davao City and who have provided educational services to the hearing impaired are considered for their Second Summer Training in 2002. Their names are listed in Enclosure No. 5.

5. All grantees are entitled to benefits and privileges indicated in Enclosure No. 4. Travel expenses to and from the venue shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies. Participants to these trainings are advised to travel by sea or land.

6. As a requirement, each participant must accomplish the Memorandum Of Agreement (Training Contract) duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (See Inclosure No. 6). This will be sent to the SPED Division, Bureau of Elementary Education together with the other documents required.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

1. Is a Bachelor's degree holder for the elementary/ secondary level.
2. Is actually teaching regular or SPED classes without training at the elementary or secondary level for at least three (3) years with Very Satisfactory performance.
3. Has a grade point average of 2.0/85 in the undergraduate/graduate/post graduate study.
4. Is not more than 45 years old.
5. If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother.
6. Has no administrative/criminal record.
7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and registers positive attitude and commitment toward work, peers and students.
8. Is willing to conduct and/or assist in in-service training activities after scholarship.
9. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses.
10. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years.
11. Can communicate in both English and Filipino with facility.

2. Performance Appraisal Rating for the past three (3) rating periods

5. Certification from Head Office (Principal/Superintendent/Chief of Elementary Education/Secondary Education Division) that the nominee is actually teaching and recommending him/her for scholarship duly endorsed by the Superintendent and Regional Director

1. Grantees of the training program at the Philippine Normal University, Cebu Normal University and Holy Cross College are entitled to free tuition fee and a monthly stipend of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00).

3. Conduct himself/herself in such a manner as not to bring disgrace or dishonor for himself/herself, his/her school/agency and the Christoffel Blindenmission.
4. Submit to the Bureau of Elementary Education/Bureau of Secondary Education at the end of the training a copy of his/her action plan;
5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her functions upon the completion or termination of his/her training;
9. Organize SPED programs or classes for the hearing impaired.
10. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two (2) years after each summer training;
11. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to Christoffel Blindenmission such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government and/or sponsor if he/she fails to provide educational services to the hearing impaired for at least two (2) years after each summer training; and
12. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
