PROJECT RESCUE INITIATIVES IN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS (RISE)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
School Principals/Administrators
Public Elementary and Secondary School Teachers

1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) and Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) through the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs) and selected teacher training institutions announces the implementation of the teacher training program of project RISE in summer of the year 2002.
2. The objective of the project is to improve/enhance the competence/capabilities of elementary and secondary science and mathematics teachers to enable them to teach science and mathematics more effectively and efficiently.
3. The participants in the training program are teachers in the elementary and secondary science and mathematics subjects. Priority shall be given to teachers who are non-majors/minors but are teaching elementary and secondary science and mathematics and have not participated in the training programs implemented by SEI at the RSTCs in the last three (3) years.
4. The participants will be provided with free training fee, stipend of P6,000 for the duration of the training, book allowance of P1,500, and one round trip actual transportation allowance in going to the training venue and back.
5. The training program will run for one hundred eighty (180) hours and will be conducted in selected teacher training institutions in the country. It should be scheduled so as not to conflict with school-based trainings on the Restructured Basic Education Curriculum. The Regional Technical Committee (RTC), composed of the regional offices of DOST, DepEd, CHED, and the selected teacher training institutions will supervise and monitor the conduct of the training program in the regions.
