**TRAINING OF HIGH SCHOOL MATHEMATICS TEACHERS**

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division Superintendents  
Principals/School Heads

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) in coordination with Ateneo de Manila University will conduct the Training for High School Mathematics Teachers in April. The following are the schedule of activities:

- a. Orientation Seminar of National Trainers  
Date: March 25-26, 2002  
Venue: Institute of Social Order (ISO)  
Loyola Heights, Quezon City
- b. Training of Division and School Level Trainers  
Batch 1: April 8-13, 2002  
Venue: Teachers' Camp, Baguio City  
Participants: Regions I-V, CAR and NCR  
  
Batch 2: April 15-20, 2002  
Venue: Teachers' Camp, Baguio City  
Participants: Regions VI-XII, ARMM, and CARAGA
- c. Training of Mathematics Teachers at Division Level  
May 4-9, 2002

2. At the end of the training program, the teachers are expected to: a) have an overview of the High School Mathematics program using the discipline based approach; b) have a good grasp and understanding of the curriculum in their respective year levels; c) know appropriate teaching strategies in the teaching of mathematics.

3. Participants who shall serve as National Trainers are listed in Appendix A. The guidelines for determining the participants in the training of division and school level trainers are found in Appendix B.

4. For training of 1a, trainor participants from the regions outside MetroManila who will undergo orientation seminar on March 25-26, 2002 are requested to check-in on March 24 at ISO, Ateneo de Manila University.

For training of 1b, participants are expected to be at the training venue not later than 3:00 p.m. on April 7, 2002 for Batch 1 and April 14, 2002 for Batch 2 for pre-training activities.

5. Travel expenses, board and lodging of participants, trainors, facilitators and staff and other incidental expenses shall be charged against OSEC and SEDIP funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is expected.

## Appendix B

### **GUIDELINES TO DETERMINE PARTICIPANTS TO THE TRAINING OF DIVISION AND SCHOOL LEVEL TRAINORS (April 8-13 and April 15-20, 2002)**

1. Division Superintendents are expected to send ten (10) mathematics teachers from each school division one (1) of which should come from the Division Leader School (DLS) with the following qualifications:
  - a. major in mathematics and must have taught mathematics for at least 5 years.
  - b. at least very satisfactory teaching performance
  - c. must be committed to conduct division and school levels training.
2. School Divisions in Regions II, VII, IX, X and CARAGA, which have PROBE In-service mathematics teacher-facilitators, shall be included in the total 10 participants per division.
3. These trainees shall form the Division Training Team and conduct training for division and school levels upon their return.
4. The Regional Offices are requested to submit the list of participants from their divisions on or before April 2, 2002 to the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) at facsimile numbers: (02) 632-77-46, (02) 633-72-67. 5. Participants to School Level Training shall include all other mathematics teachers in the high schools.
