**INTEL TEACH TO THE FUTURE PROGRAM**

TO : Regional Directors  
Regional IT Coordinators  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Public Secondary Schools Principals  
Public Secondary School Teachers

- 1) This Department, in partnership with Intel Philippines Manufacturing, Inc., will conduct the Intel Teach to the Future Program, the staff development component of the PC's for Public Schools (PCPS) Project, during the summer break of SY 2001-2002 at the different Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs) and recipient-schools of the PCPS.
- 2) The Program aims to prepare teachers for the effective use of information technology in the classroom. It is designed to build on the capability of teachers to integrate information technology in teaching-learning.
- 3) Participants in the aforementioned Program shall come from the one thousand recipient-schools under the PCPS. The other participants shall be the Regional Trainers who participated in the Intel Teach to the Future Program conducted in 2001.
- 4) Before the conduct of the training program, the Regional Trainers shall undergo a three-day refresher training scheduled as follows:

Luzon	UP-NISMED, Quezon City	April 3-5, 2002
Visayas and Mindanao	University of San Carlos, Cebu	April 10-12, 2002

- 5) The ten-day training program for the Master Trainers (one teacher per PCPS recipient school) shall be scheduled within the period 8 April to 8 June 2002, while the school-based training shall be scheduled within the period 6 May to 15 June 2002.

6) In cases where the school-based training needs to be extended beyond the prescribed dates, the Regional IT Coordinators and the school-based trainers shall ensure that the trainings do not conflict with regular class schedules.

7) Intel shall subsidize the cost of training except the travel expenses of teacher-participants, which shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting regulations and auditing procedures.

8) To effect proper implementation and ensure the efficient coordination between this Program and other training programs scheduled within the same period, all Regional Information Technology (IT) Coordinators are advised to coordinate the schedule of the Intel Teach to the Future Regional Training Program with the Regional Program Managers of the 2002 Basic Education Curriculum Training Program. Likewise, the Regional IT Coordinators are requested to submit their respective schedules to the Office of the Secretary (Attn: Mr. Patrick Salamat), Fax No. 636-4876, DepEd, Meralco Ave. Pasig City on or before 27 March 2002.

9) Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
