- 1. Pursuant to Memorandum Order No. 52 entitled constituting a National Executive Committee on the 2002 OBSERVANCE OF THE ARAW NG KAGITINGAN and PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK on April 5-11, 2002, this office joins the other government offices in the 60th celebration of the said event in Philippine History with the theme: KAGITINGAN: PANATA NG BAYAN, SIGLA NG SAMBAYANAN.
- 2. As member of the National Executive Committee, the Undersecretary of Legal Affairs encourages all DepEd Regional and Division officials and school principals to hold simple but fitting programs with the participation of pupils and students in public and private schools to commemorate the event.
- 3. Likewise, it is requested that the significance of the ARAW ng KAGTINGAN and the PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK be taken up in the classroom discussions among our pupils and students to memoristize the deeds, principles and ideals of the Filipino people as a means of enhancing patriotism and love of country, love for freedom and democracy specially among our youth and also to deepen one's understanding and awareness in promoting the heroic deeds of our Filipino veterans.
- 4. In support of the 60th year of the ARAW NO KACITINGAN, DepEd will join and participate in the programs initiated by the National Executive Committee (NEC). (Please see attachment A).

- 5. The National Executive Committee in coordination with this department (DepEd) will conduct a nationwide Essay Writing contest on the theme; KAGITINGAN: PANATA NG BAYAN, SIGLA NG SAMBAYANAN. This will be participated in by the high school students and elementary pupils both public and private schools. It will be in two (2) phases: regional and national.
 - 5.1. The regional contest shall be managed by the Regional Special Events Coordinator under the auspices of the Regional offices headed by the Regional Director with members from the Department of Local Government (DILG) and VFP Sons and Daughters, Inc. or Defenders of Bataan and Corregidor (DBC).  - 5.2. The 15 Regional Offices will submit their entries on or before April 3, 2002.
- 6. The National Committee will announce the winners on April 9, 2002 at Mt. Samat Shrine during the Araw Ng Kagitingan program with President Gloria Macapagal - Arroyo as the Guest of Honor.
