ORIENTATION AND TRAINING FOR THE DepEd KEY OFFICIALS, TEACHERS FOR THE BALIK PAARALAN PARA SA OUT-OF-SCHOOL ADULTS (BPOSA) PROJECT

- 1. DECS Order No. 41 s. 2001 mandates the transfer of the Balik Paaralan Para sa Out-of- School Adults (BPOSA) Project from the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) to the Bureau of Nonformal Education (BNFE). It could be mentioned that the BSE piloted the BP OSA project in selected secondary schools in fifteen regions.
- 2. With this development, there is a need for the Bureau of Nonformal Education (BNFE) to conduct a series of one-day orientation among the key officials and field level implementors of the Department of Education (DepEd), since the Nonformal Education Accreditation and Equivalency (NFE-A&E) System will be adopted in the implementation of the Balik Paaralan Para sa Out-of-School Adults (BPOSA) Project. The series of orientation for the DepEd field officials which include the Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents in charge of Nonformal Education, Regional NFE Division Chiefs, Division NFE Supervisors and Principal Coordinators will be conducted during the first day of the Instructional Managers training.
- 3. Likewise, the Bureau will conduct a series of Five-Day Training of teachers who will be involved as BPOSA Instructional Managers on the NFE A&E System for the BPOSA Project. It aims to equip them with the necessary knowledge, attitudes, values and skills that would ensure efficient and effective implementation of the aforementioned project using the new learning support delivery scheme.

- 4. In line with the austerity measures of government agencies, especially the Department of Education (DepEd), the aforecited series of orientation and training will be conducted by batches in geographical clusters.
- 5. Board and lodging of participants, transportation and other incidental expenses will be shouldered by the BPOSA funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of the Memorandum is desired.
