**LAKBAY KULTURA AT KASAYSAYAN:
ORIENTATION and SEMINAR WORKSHOP**

1. In line with the ongoing curriculum reform of the Department of Education (DepEd) and the National Development Plans for Cultural Education, the DepEd in cooperation with the National Commission for Culture and Arts (NCCA) will conduct a LAKBAY KULTURA AT KASAYSAYAN: ORIENTATION AND SEMINAR WORKSHOP on:

- May 19-27, 2002 for participants from Luzon
- June 2-10, 2002 for participants from the Visayas and Mindanao

2. The orientation and seminar-workshop aims to:

- a. deepen understanding and appreciation of the Filipino heritage of teachers through cultural and historical tours;
- b. enhance teaching repertoire of participants through lecturettes and integrated instructional packages on Philippine history, arts and culture; and
- c. develop integrated lesson plans for history, arts and culture.

3. Participants shall be Master Teachers, Regional Supervisors of Social Studies, Physical Education, Health, Music, Arts, Values and Technology and Home Economics (THE). Each region shall have five representatives to be drawn from the different divisions. The regional team shall be composed of 1 Social Studies, 1 PE -Health, 1 Music- Arts, 1 Values and 1 THE teachers.

4. There will be no registration fee. Participants' transportation expenses (from destination to workshop venue and back), board and lodging for eight days, and inland travel shall be charged to NCCA project funds for Lakbay Kultura through the Office of the Secretary of DepEd.

5. Expenses related to the workshop such as board and lodging, travel and honoraria of resource persons and support staff and other training handouts and materials shall be charged to the Lakbay Kultura project funds through the OSEC of DepEd. No funds shall be taken from DepEd. Releases of all funds are subject to availability, accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
