FESTIVAL OF ASIAN CHILDREN'S CONTEST WINNERS

The Mitsubishi Impression – Gallery Festival of Asian Children's Art contest organized by the Mitsubishi Public Affairs Committee, Asian Pacific Federation of UNESCO Clubs and Associations, and the National Federation of UNESCO Associations in Japan in cooperation with UNESCO National Commission of the Philippines and the Department of Education held last June to September, 2001 yielded a total of One Thousand Two (1,002) entries from all over the country.

3. The ten national winners were the following:


