Bi-Annual Conference of Secondary Education Division (SED) Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs and Planning Conference for the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) 2003

1. The first Bi-Annual conference of SED Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs for the current year as well as the planning conference for NSPC 2003 shall be held from July 22-25, 2002, at the ECOTECH, Lahug, Cebu City.

Representatives from Region 7 (SED Chiefs/Assistant Chief, Regional Paper Advisers (elementary and secondary) should be ready with their proposals for the NSPC contest venues and billeting quarters. *h*
