Theiland

General Information

Background

The ASEAN Student Exchange at Secondary Education Level has been held twice in Malaysia and Singapore in 2002 and 2001 respectively. This year, Thalland will be hosting the Third ASEAN Student Exchange at Secondary Education Level during July 14 – 27, 2002. Therefore, the Ministry of Education, Thailand would like to invite participants from 10 ASEAN Member Countries to join this program. The program will provide an opportunity for students at the secondary education level to learn more about one another's cultures and values, enhance the consolidation of ASEAN among youth of participating countries and promote friendship among youth of ASEAN.

Theme of the Program

This year, the theme of the program is Education for Conservation of Historical Sites and for the Promotion of Eco-tourism.

Objectives

The specific objectives of the program are as follows:

- 1. to promote mutual understanding among youth of ASEAN Countries.
- to encourage the exchange of cultures and values of other ASEAN Member Countries.
- To provide an opportunity for ASEAN youth to learn to live together in diverse culture.
- 4. To bring together students from ASEAN Member Countries to discuss, exchange experience and information on the conservation of historical sites and the promotion of eco-tourism.
- 5. To create a youth networking for the students from ASEAN Member Countries.

Participants of the Program

Each ASEAN Member Country will be invited to nominate six students at the high school level (age 15-17), preferably 3 boys and 3 girls, two teachers/officials to participate in the program. All participants should possess the following qualifications:

- basic knowledge of and strong interest in history and culture of ASEAN Countries, as well as an appreciation of conservation and preservation of historic monuments and sites
- skills in communicative English since English is the media of communication
 of the program.
- artistic skills, such as painting, singing, dancing and poem writing
- good health and physically fit, cycling ability since there will be a cycling rally during the program
- ability to work in a team of diverse cultures
