17TH PEACE AND COOPERATION SCHOOL AWARD

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Foundation for Peace and Cooperation, a non-governmental organization with special consultation status at the United Nations, is inviting entries to its 17th Peace and Cooperation School Award.
2. The competition will be participated in by students and teachers from all over the world and aims to promote peace and global solidarity.
3. This year's theme is "Globalization: The Great Challenge of the Millennium". Students and teachers may participate in the following categories:
 - a. Drawing: 3 to 8 years old;
 - b. Essay: 9 to 11 years old;
Write an essay (1-3 pages long) explaining why globalization is the great challenge of the millennium;
 - c. Photography: 12 to 14 years old;
Design a small photographic montage (between 4 and 8 photos, either colored or black and white), which reflects the inequalities prevalent in a particular place in the world;
 - d. Poster and Slogan: 15 to 20 years old;
Design a poster and give a slogan that would attract people's attention to globalization as a positive and negative phenomenon that combines the technologies of information, life, sciences and diversity, with the problems of poverty, health, the deterioration of the environment and violence;
 - e. Educators: Write a report (between 4 and 5 pages) about "Globalization and Peace", reflecting on the necessity of an ethical globalization to establish a more just and responsible global system; and
 - f. Special Category for All - Draw up a brief and concise script for the Foundation's TV programme "Another Mankind in the Third Millennium" recognizing the most salient points of the Peace and Cooperation School Award 2002.

4. Entries may be written in any of the six (6) official languages of the United Nations: Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian, and Spanish. These should be submitted on or before July 1, 2002 to:
