THE 2ND YOUNG WEB DESIGNERS AWARDS

Public and Private Secondary Schools Principals

- 1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI), in coordination with the Department of Education, is conducting "The 2^{nd} Young Web Designers Awards". Government agencies are enjoined to initiate and implement programs and activities to help generate awareness and public support relative to this activity.
- 2. The project is a hands-on web design competition aimed at enhancing the interests of the youth in Information and Communication Technology (ICT), thereby motivating them to pursue careers relevant to the demands of the future industries. Thus, it is deemed necessary to create awareness among the general public on the creative and productive uses of ICT.
- 3. The contest is open to Filipino students from both public and private secondary schools who can create their own web page (see Enclosure 1 for Contest Mechanics).
- 5. The ten national finalists will be notified by e-mail, telephone or mail and will be asked to proceed to Cebu Midtown Hotel for the national finals. DOST -SEI will provide for the transportation and accommodation of the finalists. Accompanying adults, if any, should provide for their own transportation and accommodation while in Cebu City.
- 6. The national winners will be awarded with the following cash prizes: First prize PhP100,000; Second prize PhP50,000; and Third prize PhP25,000. Each of the seven (7) remaining national finalists will be awarded PhP5,000 consolation prize. Additional prizes and tokens will be provided by the sponsors to the winners.

- 7. All high school institutions both public and private are invited to conduct similar activities in which students can experience the contests in the first few minutes of their classes. DepEd Order No. 20, s 2002 should be enforced in the planning and implementation of said activities.
- 8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

1.0 General Project Description

A hands-on web design competition for the youth first conducted in 2000 as a component project of the National Science and Technology Week Celebration

2.0 Objectives

- 2.1 To enhance the interests of the youth in information and communications technology or ICT
- 2.2 To encourage the youth to undertake projects using ICT
- 2.3 To motivate the youth to pursue careers relevant to the demands of the future industries
- 2.4 To identify youth talents in web design and harness their skills in S&T undertakings
- 2.5 To create awareness among the general public on the productive uses of ICT

3.0 Project Mechanics

3.1 Categories: high school and college/post-secondary (2-3 year vocational course)

3.2 Qualification of Applicants

- High School students not more than 18 years old at the time of the national competition
- College/post-secondary students (of 2-3 year courses) not more than 21 years old at the time of the national competition

- Filipino citizens
- In good health
- Of good moral character
