## THE 2003 NATIONWIDE SEARCH FOR YOUNG ART SCHOLARS OF THE PHILIPPINE HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

- 1. The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA), a state-run secondary education institution for young artists, is now accepting applications for full secondary level scholarship. PHSA conducts a yearly screening of applicants to search for artistically gifted and talented pupils who will be given special training in their chosen field of interest. The school's programs are intended to ensure a continuing source of artists of excellence and national leaders in the preservation and promotion of the Filipino culture.
- 2. The successful applicant is granted free tuition fee, free board and lodging, a monthly stipend, and the chance to represent the country in international festivals and competitions. The grant is renewable every year for four (4) consecutive school years upon satisfaction of academic and nonacademic requirements.
- 3. Applicants must be Filipino citizens with outstanding abilities in at least one of the art disciplines, i.e. Music (instrument and voice), Dance (ballet and folk), Theater Arts, Visual Arts, and Creative Writing; graduating Grade VI or VII pupils this school year 2002-2003; of above-average intelligence; proficient in oral and written Filipino and English; without any debilitating illness; willing to study in a boarding school; and determined to pursue a college degree in Architecture, Fine Arts, Music, Dance, Theater Arts, Journalism or any related courses upon graduation from PHSA.
- The application form, brochure, and poster are inclosed.
- 5. Duly accomplished application forms and other requirements should be sent directly to Executive Director Honrado R. Fernandez c/o ANSYAS 2003, NAC, Mt. Makiling, College 4031, Los Baños, Laguna.

- 6. Those who qualify in the preliminary evaluation will be directly notified by PHSA to report for examinations and live auditions at the Regional Test and Audition Centers (RTACs). The exact locations of the RTACs and dates of examinations and auditions will be announced by PHSA directly to all preliminary qualifiers.
- 7. Travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the pupils and their mentors shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing requirements.


