- 1. The National Foundation for Teachers' Development (NAFTED) Inc., a SEC-registered, PRC-accredited continuing professional education provider and a regular resource teachers' organization of both the Senate and the House of Representatives' Education Committees will be conducting a National Seminar-Workshop on Leadership and Human Rights Education on August 28-30, 2002 at the Quirino Hall, Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

The National Foundation for Teachers' Development (NAFTED), Inc., a SEC-registered, PRC-accredited continuing professional education provider and a regular resource teachers' organization of both the Senate and House Committees on Education and Culture, will be conducting a series of seminar-workshops on February 7-9; April 17-19; and May 2-4, 2002 at the Teachers' Camp, Baguio City. Each seminar-workshop aims to upgrade the participants' tool analysis, leadership capabilities and organizational management skills in such areas as grievance presentation and handling, negotiation and conflict-resolution.

Participants to these seminar-workshops are public school teachers who are officers of teachers' associations in their schools, districts or divisions and whose attendance will be considered on official time.

The registration fee of two thousand pesos (P2,000.00) shall cover food and lodging, seminar kit, certificate, honoraria of speakers and other administrative expenses of the three-day training.
