PHILIPPINE HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION (PHEA) BIENNIAL CONVENTION IN HOME ECONOMICS

To: Regional Directors

- 1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA), in coordination with the Department of Education, will hold a three-day Biennial Seminar-Convention in Home Economics Education on October 17,18, and 19, 2002 at Hotel La Trinidad Legaspi City, Albay, Philippines.
- 2. The theme of the convention is "Management of Changes in Home Economics Education."
- 3. Objectives of the convention are as follows:
 - a. Know the emerging challenges of Home Economics Education;
 - b. Analyze and interpret management of changes and its implication to the roles of school administrators, supervisors, teachers, and students; and
 - c. Make a critical analysis of the present Home Economics Elementary and Secondary Curriculum for changes due to impact of technology and globalization.
- 4. The PHEA is charging a registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500) to defray expenses for complete lodging and accommodation including complete meals and snacks and for supplies, reading materials and provisions such as kits, handouts, and resource speakers. Participants representing public schools are allowed to attend **on official time**. Private school participants can make the financial arrangements with their respective institutions.
- 5. Participants of the convention include regional and division supervisors, school heads/principals, THE department heads, chairman and coordinators, THE and EPP teachers, THE-DEPED scholars representing their respective regions, and other allied courses/subjects in private and state colleges and universities.
