YOUTH FOR ENVIRONMENT SUMMER CAMP 2003

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education - Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepEd-CSCA), the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Youth Desk and the Kabataang Sama-Samang Maglilingkod (KASAMA), Inc. will conduct the **Youth for Environment Summer (YES) Camp** on April 30 – May 4, 2003 at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

2. With its theme, "*Ugnayang Kabataan, Ugnayan sa Kalikasan at Kapaligiran*," the YES Camp serves as a significant venue to showcase the students' talents and skills through participation in environmental essay-writing contests, slogan-making contest, environmental quiz, *sayawit sa kalikasan*, *palaro sa kalikasan* and other competitions and activities as training for participatory school-based environmental campaigns. It aims to:

- 2.1 generate awareness on the state of the Philippine ecology;
- 2.2 know the causes and effects of environmental degradation and further develop the youth's appreciation and participation in school and community-based environmental programs;
- 2.3 enhance environmental leadership and values development among the students;
- 2.4 encourage to organize school-based environmental clubs and organizations that will support environmental initiatives in the grassroots; and
- 2.5 formulate an action plan and a pledge of commitment to be implemented in their own school and community to strengthen students' commitment on environmental protection and action through the implementation of relevant programs and projects in their respective clubs and organizations.

3. The participants in this camp shall be the *Sangguniang Kabataan* Officers, student leaders, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, science and environmental club officers, teacher-advisers, and education supervisors from different public and private schools nationwide. Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and School Principals are encouraged to send participants to the summer camp. The Regional Supervisors in-charge of the programs and projects of the CSCA shall undertake the coordination in the field office pertaining to their respective regional delegation and representation during the summer camp.

4. A registration fee of PhP3,100.00 shall be charged each participant to cover accommodation and meals from dinner of day 0 to breakfast of day 4, kit, certificates, speakers' honoraria, t-shirts, bags and other incidental expenses of the program, chargeable against local funds/local school board funds. Ⓞ
