#### 2003 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

Chairman, CHED

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) and the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) in coordination, with the Philippine Normal University (PNU), Cebu Normal University (CNU) and University of Southern Philippines (USP), Davao City, will conduct the Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired. This is sponsored by the Resources for the Blind, Inc., Christoffel Blindenmission Dark and Light Foundation and the Hildeshimer Foundation. The training venues and dates are found below:

Luzon Area :

Philippine Normal University (PNU)

Taft Avenue, Manila April 22 - May 16, 2003

Visayas Area

Cebu Normal University (CNU)

Cebu City

April 21 - May 17, 2003

Mindanao Area:

University of Southern Philippines (USP)

Davao City

April 23 - May 20, 2003

- 2. The program aims to enhance competencies of teachers in providing educational services to visually impaired children in regular schools.
- 3. Priority participants/nominees in the three areas shall come from the identified regions/divisions/districts/schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the visually impaired (see Enclosures No. 1). The Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee, (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 2, shall screen the nominees. Deadline for the submission of nominees to the region is set on the first week of March 2003. The nominees are advised to make a collect call to Mr. Randy Weisser, Director, Resources for the Blind, Inc. at tel. no. 726-30-21 for the interview in March 2003. The Regional Office shall submit the final list of nominees and their required documents to the Special Education Division (SPED), Bureau of Elementary Education on or before March 31, 2003.

- 4. Selected teachers who are recipients of the DepEd-RBI Summer Training Programs in Summers 2001 and 2002 are listed in Enclosure No. 4. Only those teachers who are actually providing services to the visually impaired students will be given the opportunity to continue their training in Summer 2003.
- 5. All grantees shall be entitled to free tuition fees and a monthly stipend. Grantees from Regions I, II, III, IV, V, VI and CAR under the training program at the PNU will receive a stipend of PhP2,400.00 while those from NCR shall receive PhP1,400.00. Grantees from the USP, will also receive PhP2,400.00 while those at the CNU shall receive PhP2,200.00. All grantees are advised to travel by land or sea. Travel expenses shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies.
- 6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with the required documents. Expenses for the training shall be charged to their agency funds. The nominees who will be joining the training shall pay their tuition fees to the Resources for the Blind, Inc. c/o Mr. Randy Weisser.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

- 3. Has grade point average of 2.0/85 in the undergraduate/graduate/post graduate study.
- 4. Is not more than 45 years.
- 5. If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother.
- 6. Has no administrative/criminal record.
- 7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and register positive attitude and commitment
- toward work, peers and students.
- 9. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses.
- 10. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years.
- 11. Can adequately communicate in both English and Filipino.

- 3. Conduct himself/herself in such a manner as not to bring disgrace or dishonor for himself/herself, his/her school/agency and the Resources Blind Inc;
- 4. Submit to the Bureau of Elementary Education/Bureau of Secondary Education at the end of the training a copy of his/her action plan;
- 5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her functions upon the completion or termination of his/her training;

Organize SPED programs or classes for the visually impaired. 6. 7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two (2) years after each summer training; Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to the Resources for the Blind, 8. Inc. such sums of money as many have been defrayed by the Philippine government and/or sponsor if he/she falls to provide educational services to the visually impaired for at least two (2) years after each summer training, and 9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
