**TRAINING OF TEACHER TRAINERS IN ENGLISH, SCIENCE,  
MATHEMATICS AND MAKABAYAN**

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) shall conduct the Training of Teacher Trainers in English, Science, Mathematics and Makabayan. This training shall be held in two clusters to include the project provinces of SEDIP:

- Cluster 1 covers seven (7) regions in Luzon which shall be held on March 30 – April 3, 2003 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City; and
- Cluster 2 covers three (3) regions in Visayas and six (6) regions in Mindanao which shall be held on April 21-25, 2003 at Zamboanga City.

2. The training aims to build the capacity of trainers in developing the teachers' skills to be used in the following:


- a. integrative teaching and learning;
- b. interactive learning;
- c. application of information and communication technology (ICT) in teaching and learning;
- d. customization of lesson plans to diverse learning needs; and
- e. assessment for learning.

3. Please see Enclosure No. 1 for the list of BSE participants, support staff, management staff, and number of regional participants. Enclosure Nos. 2 and 3 show the number of teacher trainers for each region. The names of the teacher trainers should be submitted to the BSE (Attn.: Mrs. Zenaida E. Espino at telefax no. 632-75-86) not later than March 15, 2003. Enclosure No. 4 contains the list of SEDIP trainers.

4. The participants to this training should preferably be Master Teachers (MTs) with potential skills and experience in teacher training. They should be at the training venue in the afternoon of Day 0 on March 29 (for Cluster 1) and on April 20 (for Cluster 2) during registration and opening program at 5:00 p.m. Dinner of Day 0 shall be the first meal and breakfast on Day 6 shall be the last meal. Attendance to this training shall be on **official business.** 9

5. The transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds, whereas, their board and lodging shall be charged against BSE project funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
