REVITALIZATION OF THE SCIENCE CLUB ADVISERS' ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (SCAAP)

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

District Supervisors

Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. Four years since the reactivation of the Science Club Advisers' Association of the Philippines as a youth-serving organization in schools nationwide by virtue of DECS Memorandum No. 40, s. 1999 dated February 4, 1999, this association of science club advisers, science teachers, science supervisors and science enthusiasts has gained much headway in achieving the goals for which it was established and in supporting the implementation of the Basic Education Curriculum. To further consolidate the membership of the association and strengthen its programs and projects in the grassroots, the Department of Education announces the revitalization of the association, otherwise known as the SCAAP. Enclosed are the guidelines and membership form.
- 2. The SCAAP is an educational, science-oriented, non-stock, non-profit, non-political and non-sectarian organization supportive of the goals of the Department of Education insofar as it concerns strengthening science education and emphasizing its role as a significant part of national development efforts. It aims, among others, to achieve the following:
 - a. promote and strengthen science awareness and its relevance among its members, the students and the general population through various relevant science clubbing activities;
 - formulate guidelines and coordinate activities and efforts on the research process, technological breakthroughs and other scientific activities for all affiliated chapters;
 - c. collaborate with the Department of Education and with other concerned agencies towards the advancement of science and technology;
 - provide venues, activities and opportunities for the professional advancement and continuous exchange of ideas among its members;
 - e. strengthen cooperation and harmonious relationship among its members throughout the country;
 - f. initiate the organization of science clubs and assist those already in existence; and,
 - g. give due recognition to the outstanding achievements of its members.

- 3. Towards these ends, all science club advisers, science teachers, science education supervisors and science enthusiasts are encouraged to join the SCAAP and to help strengthen its national, regional and division councils nationwide. All Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and School Principals and Administrators are enjoined to support the programs and projects of the SCAAP and cooperate with its representatives in their respective areas of responsibility.
- 4. As a duly recognized youth and student-serving organization, the SCAAP is authorized to initiate and conduct science promotion activities, enrichment trainings, workshops, conferences and celebrations in the national, regional, division and school levels during the National Science Club Month, summer vacation and during such time as necessary.
- 5. The SCAAP is required to submit to the Department bi-annual reports within the second week of June and December on its membership and activities held and such other reports as may be required by the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA); and shall abide by such other Department issuances and pertinent guidelines.
