SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON INTERACTIVE STRATEGIES IN THE TEACHING OF SCIENCE CONCEPTS IN THE SECONDARY LEVEL

It further provides the participants opportunity to realize their grasp of content and style of delivery for a more effective and efficient learning.

- 3. The participants to this training are those secondary school teachers teaching Science who are non-majors and whose names were officially endorsed by their Regional Directors through their Schools Division Superintendents to NEAP.
- 4. Expenses for the board and lodging of the participants, science and teaching kits and travel expenses shall be borne by the JVR Foundation. Whereas, the board and lodging, transportation fare, TEV, supplies and materials and overtime pay of NEAP staff/facilitators shall be charged against NEAP funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Participants are advised to report to the training venue a day before the scheduled start of the training and should checkout one day after the end of the training.
