CREATION OF A COMMITTEE TO REVIEW THE DECS RULES OF PROCEDURES ON DISCIPLINARY AND NON-DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of *Republic Act No. 9155* and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and in the interest of the service, a Committee to Review the DECS Rules and Regulations on Disciplinary and Non-Disciplinary Actions is hereby created.

- 3. The Committee shall be tasked to do the following:
  - 3.1 Review the existing DECS Rules and Procedures in the disposition of disciplinary and non-disciplinary actions affecting DepEd officials, employees and personnel (teaching and non-teaching staff);
  - 3.2 Revise these rules and procedures in order to conform with the provisions of RA No. 9155 and its IRR;
  - Draft administrative rules and procedures in the disposition of sexual harassment cases in the Department pursuant to Section 4 of RA 7877 in relation to CSC Resolution No. 01-0940 dated May 2001; and

- 3.4 Submit to the Secretary the following drafts:
  - 3.4.1 Revised draft of the DepEd rules and procedures in the disposition of disciplinary and non-disciplinary actions within sixty (60) days upon the issuance of this DepEd Memorandum; and
  - 3.4.2 Draft of the rules and procedures in the disposition of sexual harassment cases within forty five (45) days from the issuance of this DepEd Memorandum.
- 4. Traveling and other expenses incidental thereto, shall be charged to OSEC or regional funds, as the case maybe, subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
