**NATIONAL TRAINING ON THE BASIC LITERACY PROGRAM (BLP)**

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Nonformal Education (BNFE), through the Literacy Division will conduct the National Training on the Basic Literacy Program (BLP) for Mobile Teachers (MT) at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on April 7-11, 2003.
2. The workshop aims to: (a) orient the participants on the NFE programs, projects and in the utilization of the literacy learning materials; (b) identify problems met during the program implementation; (c) validate the MT Implementation Guidelines; (d) raise the participants' morale and level of commitment to ensure the sustainability of the program; and (e) upgrade participant's competencies through workshop on simulation exercises.
3. This activity will focus on the BLP of the BNFE which includes the following projects and programs: Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher Project (BLMTP), Literacy Service Contracting Scheme Project (LSCSP), Family Basic Literacy Project (FBLP), Basic Literacy Resource Development and Utilization Project (BLRD-UP) and Standardization Project for the Basic Literacy program (SP-BLP). Participants shall also be informed of other BNFE programs and projects.
4. The expected outputs of this activity include the following: (a) MT reports on the BLP implementation; (b) Program and Project Profiles; (c) Instructional materials and sample session guides; and (d) an organized structure to support professional concerns of the participants.
5. The participants to this Training are the 300 Basic Literacy Mobile Teachers who will implement nonformal education programs and projects in the remotest, depressed and disadvantaged areas. BNFE staff shall serve as facilitators. Management will be assisted by the NFED, CAR. Please enclosure for list of participants.
6. The registration starts on April 6, 2003. Only dinner will be served on this day. Departure will be on April 12 after serving their breakfast.
7. Expenses relative to this Training such as travel, board and lodging of all the participants will be charged against BNFE funds for the Basic Literacy Mobile Teachers Program. They can reimburse their traveling expenses by submitting official receipts and tickets upon registration. All expenses relative to this training are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
