MANAGING THE ENVIRONMENT FOR TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION: INTEL® TEACH TO THE FUTURE

1. The Intel Technology Philippines, Inc., in collaboration with this Department and SEAMEO-INNOTECH will conduct the National Forum for School Heads entitled "Managing the Environment for Technology Integration: Intel Teach to the Future" to be held at SEAMEO-INNOTECH. This Forum will be conducted in four (4) batches as follows:

3	Vi, Vii and VIII	June 19-20
4	IX, X, XI, XII and ARMM	June 26-27

- 2. The Forum aims to discuss the principal's role in ensuring the optimal use of technology in achieving better learning outcomes.
- 3. The participants to the aforecited Forum shall be the principals of the recipient-schools under the PCs for Public Schools Project (PCPSP) and the Intel Teach to the Future Program. Other participants are four specialists from the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) and the Regional IT Coordinators. Their attendance shall be on official business.
- 4. Forty (40) participants each in Batches 1 and 2 will stay behind after the Forum for a special meeting. This shall provide the opportunity for the principals and their master teachers (MTs), who will be attending a parallel workshop, to build the synergy required to support the Intel Teach to the Future Program in the school and to work out a plan for its institutionalization. The participants are required to bring a status report on the implementation of the PCPS and the Intel Teach to the Future Program of their respective schools.
- 5. Intel shall subsidize the cost of participation in the forum including meals and accommodations. Traveling expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
