- 7. Knowledge on assessment and evaluation in mathematics education.
- 8. Excellent command of written and spoken English
- 9. Have at least seven (7) years of experience in teaching, either at school or at tertiary levels.
- 10. Experience in research and development in the relevant subject area.
- 11. Experience in writing and/or editing materials on mathematics education.
- 12. Possess knowledge and skills in information and communication technology, specially those related to mathematics teaching and learning such as the Geometer's Sketchpad and the Graphic Calculator.
- 13. A person with positive work ethics, good interpersonal skills, innovative, versatile and sensitive to cultural and varying needs of individuals in multicultural and multinational groups.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. To assist in identifying, designing, teaching, managing, monitoring and evaluating training programmes, particularly those related to mathematics education.

- 10. To perform other duties and tasks as instructed by the Chairman of RECSAM Governing Board, the Centre Director and the Head of Division.

LENGTH OF SECONDMENT:

The successful candidate will be offered a two (2) year contract. The Centre may renew the appointment for a second term, pending on the satisfactory performance of the candidate.

Reminder:

1. Only short listed candidates will be called for interview.

2. Applicants who do not receive any reply from the Centre, within six months, after the closing date for application, may regard that their applications have not been successful.

3. RECSAM will not pay any expenses related to the application and attendance for interview. The Centre, whenever possible will arrange for the interview to be conducted in the applicant's country of origin.

SEAMEO RECSAM Gelugor, Penang, Malaysia Terms and Conditions of Service for Professional Staff From SEAMEO Member Countries (other than Malaysia)

- 1. The Government of Malaysia shall accord the staff member from outside Malaysia, seconded or nominated by SEAMEO Governments, the following privileges and immunities:
 - 1.1 Exemption from Malaysia income tax in respect of his/her official emoluments paid in RECSAM;
 - 1.2 The rights to import free from custom duty, furniture and personal effects within the first six (6) months of his/her arrival in RECSAM;
 - 1.3 Grant of professional visit pass to him/her spouse and unmarried children.
- RECSAM shall provide the staff member concerned with the following:
 - 2.1 An installation grant to meet the initial settling-in cost of the officer, upon first assumption of duty at RECSAM, as approved under the present scheme. The installation Grant shall be equivalent to:
 - a. fifteen days of daily subsistence allowance under the conditions indicated in Rule 4.4.3 RECSAM's Staff Rules and Regulations 1995, for the staff member and maximum of three (3) dependents who join him/her at the duty station;
 - b. seven days daily subsistence allowance for the staff member with no dependents or whose dependents do not join him/her at the duty station;
 - c. the amount payable in respect of staff members shall be calculated in accordance with the conditions and rates established by the Centre and approved by the Governing Board.

The installation grant is a once-and for-all payment appropriate to the officer's circumstances at the time of his/her arrival. No other claims such as fee for medical check-up, passport fee, exit tax, airport tax, travel tax, etc. can be made on his/her arrival or for his/her family, or when he/she returns from vacation leave or home leave from his/her extension of service. The grant shall be payable in Malaysia Ringgit.

- 2.2 Economy Class air ticket for travel from his/her official residential address of his/her home country to Penang and return upon completion of his/her contract of service at RECSAM, and where applicable, also for his/her spouse and unmarried children (maximum 3) below 18 years of age, on the condition that his/her spouse and/or children stay with him/her in Penang for a minimum of six (6) months continuously.
- 2.3 The Centre shall, to the extend and subject to conditions set out in Rule 6.1 and 6.2, pay the cost of transporting the personal effects of a staff member to the duty station, such transportation costs shall be payable, upon appointment, from the staff member's official residential address or place of recruitment to the duty station and, upon separation, from the duty station to the staff member's official residential address not exceeding RM 2,000.00.
- 3 Several flatlets are available in the Centre's Hostel Complex. A staff member who is eligible for the Housing allowance but has been provided a flatlet, shall not be paid Housing Allowance. Those who are staying at the Centre's flatlets are also to pay monthly electricity consumed. Allocation of flatlets is at the discretion of the Centre.
- 4. The Home Government concerned shall:
 - 4.1 Guarantee that the staff member's secondment or assignment to RECSAM means no loss in seniority and other earned benefits, where applicable, viz pension, gratuity, promotion prospect and other entitlements.
 - 4.2 Allow the staff member to be seconded to SEAMEO RECSAM for a period of two years for the initial secondment.
