APOLINARIO MABINI'S CENTENNIAL DEATH ANNIVERSARY

- The centennial death anniversary of Apolinario Mabini will be observed on May 13, 2003. The Department of Education (DepEd) joins the other government offices in the celebration of the said historic event.
- As a member of the Inter-Agency Organizing Committee (IAOC), this Office encourages all DepEd regional, division and district offices to hold simple and fitting programs with the participation of teachers and students from public and private schools to commemorate this event.
- Moreover, IAOC headed by the National Historical Institute (NHI) in coordination with this Department will launch the Search for Apolinario Mabini Centennial Achievement Award (AMCAA) for the 2003 high school graduates both from public and private schools. It will be held in two phases, regional and national.
- 4. Enclosed are the list of activities and guidelines on the Search.
- The transportation expenses of the awardees and the Regional Special Events Coordinators shall be charged against local funds. All other preparatory and actual expenses shall be charged to OSEC funds subject to its availability, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SEARCH FOR APOLINARIO MABINI CENTENNIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDEES (AMCAA)

- 1. The search for AMCAA aims to:
 - recognize the outstanding students in their achievements and contributions in their school and community;
 - · deepen one's pride in being a Filipino;
 - raise the level of historical/cultural awareness and consciousness of the school children relative to the significance of the centennial death anniversary of Apolinario Mabini, the Sublime Paralytic; and
 - relearn the value of the historical struggle and use them for future studies.
- 2. The qualifications of the nominees for the AMCAA are as follows:
 - a. a natural-born Filipino citizen;
 - b. enrolled in a secondary school (public/private) duly recognized by the Department of Education (DepEd);
 - c. Batch 2003 graduate with leadership and academic achievement award; and
 - d. an officer/member of a school and/or community organizations.
- 3. The regional search shall be managed by the Regional Special Events Coordinator under the auspices of the regional office headed by the Regional Director with members from the Selection/Screening Committee chaired by the Regional Special Events Coordinator. The Regional Director may appoint other members of the committee.
- 4. Each region is entitled to one (1) national awardee. The deadline for submission will be on April 25, 2003. Each awardee will have to submit a Biodata stating all his/her academic and leadership qualifications to be certified by the principal of the school he/she belongs, endorsed by the Schools Superintendent and finally nominated by the Regional Directors (please attach latest picture (2x2) and certificates if any), addressed to:
