TRAINING OF TEACHERS FOR THE SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR THE ARTS

To: Regional Directors

 Schools Division/City Superintendents Heads, Public Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), in cooperation with the Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA), Dalubhasaan sa Edukasyon ng Sining at Kultura (DESK) and the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), shall conduct a Training of Teachers for the Special Program for the Arts (SPA) on May 19-23 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The workshop aims to enhance the competencies of teachers in developing the talents of arts students from selected pilot schools.
- 3. The participants in the training workshop are teachers of the pilot schools for the SPA. Each pilot school shall send eight (8) teacher participants for the training, one each for Vocal Music, Instrumental Music, Visual Arts, Theater Arts, Media Arts, and Dance, and two (2) for Creative Writing (English and Filipino).
- 4. Transportation expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds, whereas their board and lodging shall be charged against BSE funds. Traveling expenses, board and lodging and other incidental expenses of BSE personnel shall be charged against BSE funds. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
