25th NATIONAL DISABILITY PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION (NDPR) WEEK

- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 361 dated August 19, 2000, this year's National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week will be observed on July 17-23, 2003.
- 2. The theme for this year's celebration is "Dekada K4: Kamalayan, Karapatan at Kalayaan Para Sa Taong May Kapansanan". This theme aims to advocate for and recognize persons with disabilities whom the government considers as partners in nationbuilding.
- 3. The objectives of the celebration are to:
 - a. stimulate public awareness on disability issues and concerns that will strengthen the involvement of the different government and nongovernment organizations including Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) themselves and the media;
 - b. serve as a vehicle of information for programs being implemented by government agencies including non-government organizations that adhere to the promotion of the welfare of PWDs;
 - encourage every Filipino citizen to take active responsibility in the upliftment of the economic and social conditions of the PWDs in our society, thereby encouraging them to take pro-active roles in nationbuilding;
 - d. generate full media support and participation on disability concerns; and
 - e. develop and strengthen cooperation and forge a strong partnership between and among all sectors of the Philippine society for better understanding of disability issues and concerns.
- 4. The DepEd officials are encouraged to observe the week-long celebration with appropriate activities in their respective schools/divisions/regions in accordance with DepEd Order No. 20, s. 2003. The following are the suggested activities that may be undertaken:

 - c. Poster Making Contest
 - d. Quiz Bee Contest
