DepEd NATIONAL ENGLISH PROFICIENCY PROGRAM (NEPP)
PHASE III: ORIENTATION FOR ADMINISTRATORS
TO SUPPORT THE MENTOR PROGRAM

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education launched the National English Proficiency Program (NEPP) last April 2003 in answer to the directive of President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo and the Department of Education to take urgent measures to improve the teaching of English in all schools.
- 2. The NEPP is a five-phased integrated program that includes the following activities:
 - Phase! Self-Assessment Test (SAT) a two-hour test administered to selected high school teachers of Math, Science and English. The test indicates areas of strength and weakness in English comprehension.
 - Phase II Mentor Training Program (MTP): Facilitating Mentor Learning (for Teachers) is for teachers who are high scorers in the Self-Assessment Test, have at least 3 years of teaching experience, have good communication skills and have potential to be trainers and mentors. The training is handled by the Ateneo Center for Language Teaching (ACELT) with faculty coming from Ateneo University, Far Eastern University, Philippine Normal University and the Department of Education.
 - Phase III National Trainers Training in Mentoring is a two-day training by the ACELT faculty to transfer the knowledge and process of mentoring to selected DepEd trainers who have taken the 10-weeks training in England under the Philippine English Language Training (PELT) and who are regular trainers. They will be co-trainers of the ACELT faculty and later will take charge of the Mentor Training in the regions.
 - Phase IV Orientation for Administrators to Support the Mentor Program Administrators of schools where the trained teacher-mentors come from will be given a one-day orientation, which includes an overview of the framework, philosophy, and implementation of the Mentor Program, so

that they can define their role in supporting the implementation of the school-based Mentor Program.

Phase V - Monitoring and Follow-up of the NEPP-MTP Selected sites and schools will be monitored where the trained teacher-mentors are implementing their mentoring of coteachers. A NEPP Newsletter will be published to record best practices and a National Conference will be held with representatives from all the regions to synthesize results of the

school-based Mentoring Program.

3. To strengthen the implementation of the program, the Department of Education will conduct Phase IV – Orientation for Administrators to Support the Mentor Program with the following objectives:

a. to orient administrators on the concept and processes of the Mentor Program;

 to present to them school-based Mentoring Plans made by the trained teachers who were trained in the 6-day Mentor Training Program which required them to mentor at least 20 co-teachers for the first year;

c. to discuss support mechanisms on their level, to institutionalize the

Mentor Program in the schools; and

d. to draw up division and regional plans to implement, support and sustain the Mentor Program with the present trained teachers and for future training of more teachers who will be mentors in the division.

- 4. In line with this, the Department of Education will conduct the Orientation for Administrators to Support the Mentor Program right after the six-day Mentor Training Program for Teachers on the following dates and venues:
 - NCR July 8, 2003, Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepEd, Pasig City

Visayas – July 28-29, 2003, Ecotech, Lahug, Cebu City

- Luzon August 11-12, 2003, Legenda Suite, Subic, Zambales
- Mindanao October 27-28, 2003, Grand Regal Hotel, Davao City
- 5. A total of 915 administrators will be invited to the orientation as follows:

NCR – 218 administrators VISAYAS – 203 administrators LUZON – 279 administrators MINDANAO – 215 administrators

- 6. For National Capital Region (NCR) administrator-participants, they are expected to register at the Department of Education at 7:00 a.m. For Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao, administrators are expected to check-in at the site at 1:00 p.m. of the first day. The Orientation will end at 4:00 p.m. of the second day. Region and division administrators are requested to submit by fax the names of participants with their position and contact numbers to National Educators Academy of the Philippines, telefax no. 638-8638, attention to Marina Cruz, Maria Fe Moncada or Pearl Intia.
- 7. Expenses for the Orientation which includes board and lodging of participants except for NCR, handouts and other materials will be charged to OSEC funds, however, transportation will be charged against local funds.

- 8. Other expenses which include honoraria, board and lodging of external resource persons, transportation, board and lodging and TEV's, overtime pay for NEAP-SDD staff, supplies, handouts, rental of equipment and facilities, communication costs and other incidental expenses will be charged against OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
