WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

Workshop 1 "Managing Clients with Conduct Disorders and Borderline Personalities"

This workshop is designed to equip participants with knowledge to identify clients exhibiting symptoms of conduct disorders and borderline personalities. Participants will also be given the opportunity to apply their knowledge and skills through counseling simulations.

Workshop 2 "Self-Efficacy towards Life Satisfaction"

This workshop is designed to provide participants with basic concepts and guidelines in assessing subjective judgments or beliefs about their capabilities to effectively counsel a client and manage life concerns that influence proficiency and life satisfaction. The participants will go through various structured learning experiences which will enhance their personal and professional life skills.

Workshop 3 "Career Management Process"

Guided by a Career Management Model, the participants of this workshop shall learn to help others plan and manage their careers.
