SECOND NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON eLEARNING

- 1. The Second National Conference on eLearning will be held on August 7-8, 2003 at the Manila Hotel, Roxas Blvd., Manila. The Conference is a project of the Office of the President and is organized by the Information Technology and E-Commerce Council (ITECC) through its Human Resource and Development Committee.
- 2. With the theme "Integrating eLearning into Education and Industry", the Conference aims to bring together educators, administrators, planners, technology providers and leaders in industry interested in exploring the potential of using new technologies in eLearning. The Conference will also be a venue for sharing experiences, launching of collaborative activities and setting goals for future development efforts.
- 3. Participants to the Conference include school administrators, teachers, Regional IT Coordinators, educators and educational planners from the basic education, vocational-technical education and higher education sub-sectors. Attendance to this Conference shall be **on official business**.
- 4. A Pre-Conference Workshop that focuses on best practices in integrating technology into the classroom will be held on August 6, 2003 at Southeastern College, Taft Avenue, Manila. Each participant shall be charged One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00) for this one-day activity.
- 5. For the main Conference, a fee of Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover the costs of conference materials, access to exhibits and food during conference hours. Conference fee and other incidental expenses relative to the participation in the Conference shall be charged against local school board and/or office funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
- 6. Enclosed are the lists of participating schools, registration form, and the conference announcement which contains the registration procedures.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

2nd National eLearning Conference PRE-CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS

Everyone is invited to joint the skills-based (i.e. "how to") pre-conference workshops of the 2nd National elearning Conference, which will focus on best practices in integrating technology into the classroom through teaching demonstrations/simulations to showcase pedagogies and methodologies. Participants can choose any one of the four available whole day workshops: Managing Online Learning in Your Organization, Designing elearning Courses for Higher Education, Integrating elearning Into Basic Education, and Multimedia Authoring with Advanced PowerPoint.

Managing Online Learning in Your OrganizationMaximilian N Hong

This one-day workshop will underscore how elearning can benefit organizations and will help participants determine which elearning medium would be the most appropriate model for their organization's training requirements. Furthermore, it will look into the participant's organization's current training/education strategy and identify the challenges it faces. From thereon, the workshop will guide participants through methods that will ensure that elearning projects are properly conceptualized and fully realized. The workshop is open to education and industry managers and administrators. (50 participants)

Designing elearning Courses for Higher Education

Patricia B Arinto

In this one-day workshop, participants will mine the Web for teaching and learning resources suitable for the courses they teach, and design online learning activities that take advantage of the Internet as an educational tool. A special focus of the workshop is designing WebQuests. Participants will go through the instructional design process in order to come up with creative online learning activities that foster critical thinking and collaborative learning. The workshop is open to college and university teachers who are thinking of including online components in a face-to-face course or transforming a course for full online delivery. Participants are expected to have basic knowledge in the use of computers and the Internet. (30 participants)

Integrating eLearning Into Basic EducationMercedes T Rodrigo, PhD

This day-long workshop will introduce elementary and high school teachers to telecollaboration. which refers to the use of computer technology to engage geographically dispersed groups in educational activities. It aims to acquaint participants with the constructivist principles behind telecollaboration through discussions, concrete examples, and a variety of hands-on telelcollaborative activities. At the end of the workshop, the participants would have designed telecollaborative activities of their own. Hopefully, the workshop will also serve as a venue to identify possible telecollaborative partners. The workshop is open to elementary and high school teachers interested to use computer technology in their pedagogy. Participants are expected to have basic knowledge in the use of computers and the Internet. (30 participants)

Multimedia Authoring with Advanced PowerPoint

Multimedia Authoring with Advanced PowerPoint is a whole day hands-on workshop geared for teachers and technical persons that will showcase the advanced features of PowerPoint as a multimedia authoring tool. Aside from this, the workshop will demonstrate how PowerPoint can be used as an effective teaching tool to present audiovisually enhanced lectures, create presentations, deliver exams, and the like. Parlicipants to the workshop are expected to have basic knowledge in the use of computers, particularly in the use of PowerPoint. (25 participants)
