THE STUDENTS ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (SAC-CD) PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES, SY 2003-2004

- 1. The Students Assistance Committee for Community Development (SAC-CD), a DepEd-supervised Committee, shall hold the National Evaluation Seminar (NES) for SY 2003-2004 in October at the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP), Tagaytay City.
- 2. School officials in public and private institutions, especially those in depressed provinces are encouraged to send student-delegates to this seminar, to organize a Youth Community Service Club (YCSC) in their schools, and to work on community projects throughout the year. During the summer recess, provincial YCSC councils are urged to work in a barangay immersion project. These activities are done annually.
- 3. SAC-CD extends financial assistance to this seminar. No registration fee shall be collected. However, transportation expenses may be charged against school funds, subject to its availability, usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
