2003 NATIONAL LITERACY CONFERENCE

To: Bureau Directors
Directors of Services, Centers and Heads of Units
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. In celebration of the annual Literacy Week, the Department of Education, through the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC), in cooperation and coordination with other Government Organizations (GOs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Private Organizations (POs), and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), will hold the National Literacy Conference for the year 2003 at Leyte Park Resort Hotel, Magsaysay Boulevard, Tacloban City, Leyte on September 3-5.
- 2. The theme of the conference is "Functional Literacy: A Tool for Poverty Alleviation and National Solidarity Towards a Strong Republic".
- 3. The conference is designed to alleviate poverty and to promote National Solidarity by:
 - a. identifying outstanding grassroots initiatives in functional literacy designed to address multi-cultural diversity and other socio-cultural contexts that affect learning and knowledge acquisition;
 - \$oliciting views and perspectives that provide insights for evolving strategies in delivering education for the indigenous peoples of the country; and
 - serving as a venue for sharing experiences in implementing functional literacy programs which focus on economic productivity and the upliftment of the quality of life of the disadvantaged sector.
- 4. The following participants are expected to attend the conference:
 - a. Bureau, Center and Regional Directors or their representatives;
 - Bureau/Regional Chiefs, two (2) supervisors and (2) coordinators for Nonformal Education (with entries/winners of NLA):
 - Two (2) Schools Division Superintendents per region, especially those from provinces with the lowest literacy rates or regions with winning entries; and
 - d. Three (3) Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) involved in universalizing literacy in every region.

- 5. Transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds or agency/organization funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The LCC will underwrite the accommodation, meals and snacks for all the participants in the conference. Enclosed is the tentative program of activities.
