Qualifications

- 1. A university, college or technical/vocational school diploma
- 2. A national of a SEAMEO member country between the ages of 19 and 30 who is unemployed or underemployed
- 3. Basic Knowledge of English
- 4. Maturity and social stability
- 5. Sensitive to cross cultural situations
- 6. Good health and resilience
- 7. Openness to learning
- 8. Prior knowledge of host country is an advantage
- 9. Has clear and concise career path plan or job search strategy

Other Requirements

- 1. Assume the cost of travel related expenses, such as airfare, visa, passport, etc.
- 2. Obtain proper health and medical coverage
- 3. Provide the SEAMEO Secretariat with information concerning hi/her employment for a period of three years after completing the internship

Stages

- 1. Pre Internship Stage Upon acceptance, interns attend a brief orientation programme at the respective Ministries/Department of Education of their origin.
- Overseas Assignment For six months, host institutions/organizations will provide interns a monthly allowance of US\$150 and facilitate attachments to the institution where the interns will be assigned. Both the intern and the host will design and develop the programme of activities based on the interns' needs.
- 3. Monitoring and Evaluation Evaluation will be conducted through observation surveys and interviews, including peer evaluation, intern evaluation by the mentors and intern's evaluation of the programme.
- 4. Job Search Support Period Interns will be awarded a certificate of completion and an assessment report, including recommendations to possible employment opportunities. They will also be considered for short-term contract jobs.
