- 1. To celebrate the 103<sup>rd</sup> Foundation Anniversary, PNU will hold a seminar-workshop entitled "Changing Lives... Educators' Training on Transformative Education" from September 29 to October 1, 2003 at the Grand Ballroom of the Manila Pavilion, United Nations Avenue, Manila.
- 2. The seminar-workshop aims to: (a) prepare school and interested community leaders for initiating a comprehensive approach in developing a successful character' based school improvement program; (b) provide strategies for creating a school and classroom environment in which positive character traits and behavior are modeled, internalized, and actualized; (c) create understanding, involvement, and support among parents, community leaders, business, churches, media, higher education, and other community members for school improvement through character education; and (d) propose a customized/localized action plan for the Changing Lives Program.
- 3. Expected participants are teachers (elementary and secondary), administrators and parents from both public and private schools as well as the facilitators from National Service Training Program (NSTP), teacher trainers from teacher education institutions, parateachers and community leaders.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for snacks, lunch, handouts, certificate, and other expenses relative to this seminar-workshop.
- 5. Participants coming from public institutions are allowed to attend **on official time only**. Those coming from the private institutions may make arrangements with their respective administrators.
